#### Focus: How Your Identity Makes a Difference with Unbelievers

#### Scripture Reading

- 2 Corinthians 6:17-18
- Matthew 5:13-16
- Galatians 5:22-26

#### Questions for Discussion

- According to 2 Corinthians 6:17-18, we are called to look different from the rest of the world. What do you think the Bible means when it says we are to look different from the world?
- Read Matthew 5:13-16. What are we supposed to be like?
- We are to flavor the world. We are to add to the world things that taste good. Discuss what kinds of things taste good.
- We are created and called to add to the world, flavors that taste good, rather than the world putting its flavor on us. How can you flavor the world today?
- We are also called to not hide under a what? We are created and called to shine for Jesus and put God on display. We are created and called to influence the world around us. What does that look like or could it look like in your life?
- Read Galatians 5:22-26. This passage lists the fruit of having God's Spirit in us. This means that as we follow God and live as He asks us to, this list of things would be seen in our lives. The scriptures call them the Fruit of the Spirit. Can you list them and write them out?
- Having this list of things in our lives is how we display God to the world. What are some things you can do to display God?
- Share how interacting with your Identity in Christ has affected you over the past month.
- What is one takeaway from the month that you want to continue interacting with?
